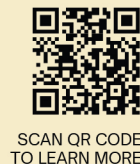

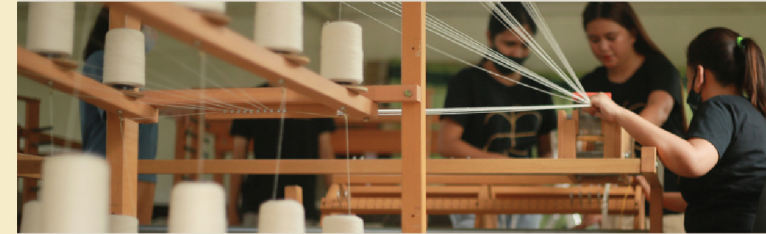


Our Programs

We've presented to the Pasig local government unit and created the "Weaving in the City" program. This program aims to introduce handweaving as a livelihood for zero-knowledge weavers. With equipment investment from the foundation and training for weaving, it has since grown into a weaving center, providing a sustainable source of livable income for marginalized members, especially women in the City of Pasig.
